ACTIVITY FROM THU, JUNE 30, 2016 THROUGH WED, JULY 13, 2016

PERMITS: Twelve permits for single-family dwellings were issued in this period. Other permits issued were for five accessory structures, one sign and one fence. Also, two Parks Permits were issued. Last year, we issued the 65th house permit on Sept. 16th. This year to date we have a 26% increase over 2015 in single-family dwelling permits (65 vs. 51), and a 40% increase in total Zoning actions (193 vs. 138), not counting Parks Permits.

The following chart compares numbers of Zoning Permits issued for the last six years. Numbers through 2015 are totals for each year. 2016 numbers are year-to-date, through July 13. The revenue line is the amount generated by Zoning Department fees.

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


REVENUE PROJECTIONS

1. Salt Bids

- 1.1. Once again this year we participated in the SWOP4G bid for road salt for the 2016/2017 season. This year 77 entities placed request thought this bid, I'm happy to report the bids came back very favorable with Beavercreek Township bid price of \$58.45 a ton which is a \$9.44 decrease from last season. I will be recommending accepting the bid from Compass Minerals America. Compass is the same supplier from last season and we had excellent service, the purchase request for 200 tons that was opened to fill the salt barn has not been place do to the early release of this bid and will be used to fill the barn at a cheaper price,
- 1.2. I make a motion to accept the road salt bid from Compass Minerals America for the 2016/2017 season at a price of \$58.45; and to authorize the Township Administrator to sign for the Board.

TO: Participants in the Highway Rock Salt Bid

We opened the bids for the rock salt yesterday (Wednesday, June 28, 2016). Attached is a bid tab for your review.

Five bidders bid the 130,175 Tons of salt for 77 entities. Of this tonnage, Compass Minerals gave the low bid for 65,425 Tons (50%), Morton was low for 50,700 Tons (39%) and Cargill for 14,050 Tons (11%). This pricing is based on dumped salt, and does not take into consideration piling charges. You will want to carefully evaluate the bids, since piling charges will change the overall bid price if you need a piler. The apparent low bidder may not be low for your entity when piling charges are figured in.

As in past bids, this bid was written to allow each entity the right to require a performance bond. If you require a bond, notify the company when you place your order. They should send you a copy.

I am recommending each entity make the award to the company giving the lowest and best price for that entity. When determining lowest and best bid, be sure to note piler charges (see the bottom of the bid tab). You will need to choose the lowest and best bid for your entity and make your own award, using your normal award process (purchase order, letter of intent, etc.). Also note on your order whether you need a piler with your delivery. As in the past, your orders need to reference the SWOP4G bid coordinated by the City of Middletown. Please let me know who you place your final order with so I can note it to the file. A short e-mail to koppinl@mcoho.org, or a quick call to 937-225-4759, would be fine. If you award to other than the low bidder on the bid tab (considering piling charges), please call me to discuss so I have an answer for the salt companies when they call to ask why they were not awarded the bid. **The integrity of the bid rests on placing orders with the low bidder.** If you have specific reasons why you can't go with the low bidder, please call me to discuss.

Please notify the supplier as soon as you are able of your intent to award so they may get you set up in their delivery system and be prepared for your orders when the weather starts rolling in.

3) Biweekly Activity Report

3.1) Senior Staff Meeting: The fire department's senior staff met to discuss items of interest and concern, including the imminent retirement of BC Betsinger, Presidential Debate planning, and Active Shooter training.

3.2) Fiscal Office Support: Paycor access to custom reporting still has not been restored to DC Mercs or FC VandenBos. The work completed by Administrator Zaharieff and Chief VandenBos will provide the necessary information for reporting and planning purposes. Unfortunately and un-necessarily, it will still take the Township Administrator's time to execute the biweekly report.

Also, the fire department has not received its regular, biweekly status reports in over five weeks. The new assistant to the fiscal officer has offered to provide the requested reports and will coordinate with DC Mercs upon his return from scheduled leave.

Finally, lack of documentation from the fiscal office regarding the creation of additional cost center codes required unnecessary troubleshooting and work product revision from the Township Administrator and Fire Chief for the tax budget planning process. The affected documents could also have been generated by the UAN; including by Department level employees if the UAN was installed in the State supported multi-user configuration.

3.3) Active Shooter Training: The fire department will be conducting annual joint training with Beaver Creek Police, Greene County Sheriff, Beaver Creek Schools and Beaver Creek CERT. This is the 5th consecutive year for this training, and the fire department will be focusing on victim removal and triage. The CERT team will also be working on triage. Training will occur July 25-29, from 1500-2300 at Ankeney Middle School.

3.4) Fire Hydrant Data Update: The fire department is updating its entire fire hydrant database. The old information is being archived and replaced with current information provided by the Sanitary Engineering department. It is also now cross-referenced to water main, valve, address, PSISN fire hydrant and parcel information. A total of 2871 fire hydrants have been updated, with an estimated additional 100 that are undocumented by the County (including private systems like Mt. St. John) to be added. This data update is coordinated with the fire hydrant testing to ensure all new captured data is validated prior to system entry.



3.5) Labor-Management Meeting: The monthly meeting was cancelled by mutual agreement due to lack of agenda items.

3.6) YouthWorks Employees: The 2016 YouthWorks program employees continue to make excellent progress supporting the fire department. During the past two weeks they did have a reduced work period due to the Independence Day holiday. Year-to-Date, they have completed:






