A RESOLUTION TO ENACT A TOWNSHIP PERMISSIVE MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE TAX PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE 4504.18

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Beavercreek Township, Greene County, Ohio, recognize the importance of maintaining township roads and that the funds available for road maintenance remain stagnant while the cost of road maintenance is increasing; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code 4504.18 allows the Board of Trustees to levy an annual license tax upon the operation of motor vehicles on the public roads and highways in the "unincorporated territory" of the township for the purpose of paying for the construction, reconstruction, improvement, maintenance, and repair of township roads, bridges, and culverts; the costs and expenses of enforcing and administering the license plate tax; for purchasing, erecting, and maintaining traffic signs, markers, lights, and signals; for purchasing road machinery and equipment; and for planning, constructing, and maintaining suitable buildings to house road equipment; and

WHEREAS, per Ohio Revised Code 4504.18, public notifications were published in the Dayton Daily News on October 23, 2016 announcing two public hearings which were held on November 7, 2016, and November 21, 2016 to provide information and accept comments about a proposed \$5.00 permissive motor vehicle license tax (additional township license tax); and

WHEREAS, four (4) residents from the Township appeared at the November 7, 2016 hearing and three (3) residents appeared at the November 21, 2016 hearing to voice their concerns and have their questions addressed and answered by the Board of Trustees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BEAVERCREEK TOWNSHIP, GREENE COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

Section 1. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 4504.18, an annual license tax is levied upon the operation of motor vehicles on the public roads and highways in the registration district know as the unincorporated area of Beavercreek Township, Greene County, Ohio.

Section 2. Such tax shall be levied at a rate of five dollars and zero cents (\$5.00) per motor vehicle on all motor vehicles the owners of which reside in the registration district know as the unincorporated area of Beavercreek Township, Greene County, Ohio.

Section 3. The intent of this Resolution is to levy the full tax a township is allowed to annually levy under Ohio Revised Code 4504.18.

Section 4: The Board of Trustees of Beavercreek Township, Greene County, Ohio, will enact a \$5.00 permissive motor vehicle license tax which will take effect 30 days after adoption of this Resolution as the earliest date allowed by law.

Section 5: All revenues realized by Beavercreek Township, Greene County, Ohio, pursuant to the Resolution is used only for the purpose allowed under Ohio Revised Code 4504.18.

Section 6: That this Board of Trustees hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.



Our Mission:




Figure 1: Visual Map of Fire, Road, and Zoning Programs

Our Competitive Advantages:

Beavercreek Township enjoys several characteristics and circumstances which elevate our community in the crowded field of potential development destinations.

- Beavercreek Township residents enjoy paying no income taxes levied by the Township. This sets our community apart from competitors for economic development such as the Cities of Xenia and Fairborn. Even though the City of Beavercreek currently levies no

income tax, an environmental scan suggests that one must soon be levied to support existing municipal operations. The lack of an income tax benefits residents as they keep more of what they earn, and entices commercial developers who wish their new employees to do the same.

- The unincorporated area of Beaver Creek Township has a significant reserve of undeveloped land available for commercial and residential development. This is attractive to developers because it offers them the flexibility to design facilities that fit their needs. New development benefits Township residents by increasing the economic base of our community, which allows the Township to provide more and better municipal services.
- The Government of Beaver Creek Township enjoys an excellent reputation among residents for quick and effective public and safety service delivery that is responsive to their needs. This is beneficial to our residents because they enjoy a safer and more comfortable community that reflects traditional “bedroom community” ideals. This is attractive to potential developers who factor municipal service delivery into their decisions about which communities are desirable locations for new homes and businesses

Xenia Township has greatly benefited from the Shared Services Agreement in place with Beavercreek Township. One of our current projects with you regarding our Full-Time Firefighter's Collective Bargaining Agreement has come to a close.

We would like to commend your Board of Trustees for helping us significantly reduce the cost of this project. Over the last 18 months Xenia Township has paid Beavercreek Township \$6,845.20 in labor and mileage. Had the Township hired a lawyer for similar services we estimated it could cost upwards of \$35,000. We are thankful to your Trustees for their commitment to making Local Government work by sharing resources.

We would also like to commend your human resources manager, Trish Gustafson. She balanced 127 hours in this project meeting both your Township demands and our Township needs. She did so with the highest degree of professionalism, integrity, and efficiency. Ms. Gustafson used her vast experience and applied wisdom to help our Township's contract needs. It is no small feat to craft a "first contract" language.

Now that this Collective Bargaining Agreement project is completed, we look forward to working on the short term, 10 hour project that your Trustees have already approved. It will help us complete an upgrade to our Personnel Handbook.



PERMITS: Four single-family dwelling permits were issued in this period. No other Zoning Permits were issued. Two minor revisions were approved to previously issued house permits. Two Parks Permits were issued, including the first permit for 2017. Last year, we issued the 94th house permit on Dec. 14th. This year to date we have a 9% increase over 2015 in single-family dwelling permits (94 vs. 86), and a 14% increase in total Zoning actions (304 vs. 266), not counting Parks Permits.

The following chart compares numbers of Zoning Permits issued for the last six years. Numbers through 2015 are totals for each year. 2016 numbers are year-to-date, through November 30. The revenue line is the amount generated by Zoning Department fees.




REVENUE PROJECTIONS







WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code §5705.36(A)(4) states that upon a determination by the Fiscal Officer that the revenue to be collected will be less than the amount included in an official certificate and that the amount of the deficiency will reduce available resources below the level of current appropriations, the Fiscal Officer shall certify the amount of the deficiency to the County Budget Commission, and the Commission shall certify an amended certificate reflecting the deficiency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, with total resources now estimated to be \$77,145.28, the Board of Beavercreek Township Trustees, hereby recognizes the deficiency of resources in the Cemetery Fund; and

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fiscal Officer is authorized to certify the amount of the deficiency to the County Budget Commission with the attached "Supplemental Certificate of the Total Amount Available from All Sources Available for Expenditures and Balances."
